Detecting truth-related differences between perfective and imperfective aspect in Polish while using Likert scale with joint presentation: Experimental results

Abstract

Perfective matrix verbs in Polish, in contrast to their imperfective counterparts, tend to systematically trigger factivity or veridicality of propositional complements they embed. The type of the inference (factivity, veridicality, implicature) depends on the semantic class the perfective embedding verb belongs to. In my talk I will present results of the acceptability judgement study (Likert scale with joint presentation) showing different behavior of: 1) (im)perfective incremental theme verbs, and 2) (im)perfective verbs of communication with regard to triggering the truth-oriented meaning of their sentential complements.
